Who did Trump offer a pardon right before leaving the White House?



Ex-president Donald Trump pardoned several of his companions and close friends on the last day of his presidency. Among them is the very prominent name of Steve Bannon, the previous chief strategist for the Trump administration.

Bannon was indicted for defrauding hundreds of thousands of people in raising funds for a wall on the southern border allegedly.

One of 73 pardons Trump issued on his last day in the office after midnight and over 70 commutations.

Another notable name to receive a presidential pardon is the rapper Lil Wayne. He received a complete pardon for being charged with owning ammunition, including a firearm from a felon. The rapper endorsed Trump's campaign for elections in November with a picture of himself with the President of that time.

Bill Kapri, or the famous Kodak Black, the rapper also had his sentence commuted along with Micheal Harris, the co-founder of Death Row Records.

Another name on the list is Elliot Briody, who was formerly a fundraiser for the Republican National Committee.

Trump also pardoned Paul Erickson, who also worked as a fundraiser and whose girlfriend of Russian descent worked as an agent in Russia.

Biden gave his speech at the Major Joseph R (Beau) Biden, the third Armed Forces Reserve Center named after his late son, who lost his battle to cancer in 2015 after serving in Iraq with Delaware Army National Guard.
