














CORONA VIRUS- COVID-19



Though not unprecedented, the world is fighting its biggest pandemic in recent memory. Since the virus originated in the city of Wuhan in China it has spread to almost all countries of the world leaving thousands dead and thousands in dire situations.

According to www.webmd.com, the coronavirus disease 2019, or COVID-19, is a disease that can cause what doctors call a respiratory tract infection. It can affect your upper respiratory tract (sinuses, nose, and throat) or lower respiratory tract (the windpipe and lungs).

The COVID-19 outbreak quickly spread around the world. It spreads the same way as other coronaviruses do, mainly through person-to-person contact. Infections range from mild to serious.

The virus, SARS-CoV-2, mainly spreads from person to person. The symptoms may include coughing, fever, fatigue and sometimes in severe cases, shortness of breath.

Most of the time it spreads when a sick person coughs or sneezes. Their droplets can spray as far as 6 feet. If you breathe or swallow them, the virus can get into your body. Some people who have the virus don't have symptoms, but they can still spread the virus.

You can also get the virus from touching a surface or object the virus is on and then touching your mouth, nose, or possibly your eyes. Most viruses can live on surfaces for several hours.

CORONA VIRUS- COVID-19: How to prevent the spread?

- Wash your hands often with soap and water or clean them with an alcohol-based sanitizer. This kills viruses on your hands.
- Practice social distancing. Because you can have and spread the virus without knowing it, you should stay at home as much as possible. If you have to go out, stay at least 6 feet from others.
- Don't touch your face. Coronaviruses can live on surfaces you touch for several hours. If they get on your hands and you touch your eyes, nose, or mouth, they can get into your body.

There's no need to wear a face mask unless your doctor tells you to. You will need one if you've been exposed to SARS-CoV-2 or have COVID-19 or if you're a health care worker or caring for someone who has it.

Clinical trials are underway in the U.S. and China to test vaccines for SARS-CoV-2/COVID-19.

How to help communities?

COVID-19 is in the U.S. now, and there are plenty of good resources you can read to understand how it's affecting Americans and their communities. You should stay informed while practicing the social distancing measures recommended by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), but there are also some actions you can take to help those who are most vulnerable now.

People are under an unusual amount of stress during this time. The CDC notes that people could be experiencing sleeplessness, trouble concentrating, or worsening chronic health conditions just from the amount of pressure they feel about the virus. Lack of resources, income, and uncertainty about the future certainly isn't helping. A good way to relieve some stress for someone else is to give them something they need. Now more than ever, it's important to reach out to those who might be at risk of getting sick. If you're young and healthy, looking out for those who are at risk of COVID-19 can be an important part of "flattening the curve" of this outbreak. While you're making your list of indoor activities and books you want to read in the coming weeks, add some charitable tasks.

The Red Cross has an urgent need for blood donations because of the outbreak. On its site the organization explains: "Donating blood is a safe process and people should not hesitate to give or receive blood. Right now eligible and healthy donors are strongly urged to make an appointment to give soon." Help the vulnerable and support health workers too. Remember to pray for the wellness of the entire world as we pray that God sees us through these times!


