## How will the Trump administration's vaccine reach all the Americans?



It'll take nearly ten years for Trump's administration's vaccine to reach enough Americans.

The goal of Operation-Warp-Speed is to vaccinate 80% of America's population by late June. For which it needs 3 million Americans vaccinated every day.

But of the 11.5 million, only 2 million have received their shots as reported by NBC.

Gottlieb revealed his few concerns, including that the vaccine is partially protective after the first dose admitting the partial protection's uncertainty of magnitude and lifespan.

Biden blasted Trump's administration later on Tuesday for falling short. Trump shifted the blame on the state while mocking Biden with false claims.

White House reported their progress in nationwide vaccination on Tuesday.

Dr. Celine Gounder and Dr. Ashish Jha have warned that the shots might fall short.

The operation spokesman stated that there's a lag between the shots received and the ones recorded.

Trump vowed to ship out 100 million shots at the year's end. This number has sliced down to 20 million in December.

Dr. Anthony Fauci reported that the numbers hadn't reached their goal. Giroir assured about the gradual increment of shots received.

## How Will Families Survive During Covid After McConnell Blocks Senate to Pass \$2000 Relief Bill?



Although Mitch McConnell proceeded with Trump's order of increasing stimulus payments, the result in GOP's-controlled-chamber is unclear.

McConnell's objection to the increment of stimulus affected Chuck Schumer's bill for the payment of \$2000.

Although democrats seconded McConnell, he is unclear on his reaction with regards to the Senate. At the same time, he was considering the current Trump election-issues.

McConnell revealed he has few priorities to be dealt with first, which, when added with "legislative package," may gain GOP support but lose Democrats hindering the process of direct payments' increment.

McConnell is increasing the stimulus to \$2000 but annulling Section 230 while creating a Bipartisan election commission made it happen.

Schumer urged republicans to pressure McConnell to hold his vote on house's Monday's measures realizing the bill won't pass in the place.

Noting McConnell's blocking is due to Schumer's advances, Trump tweeted criticizing and insultingly to approve \$2000 payments while also hinting to look after the Big Techs and Democrats.

Republican Senators also favored Trump's support for increased payments. This includes David Perdue and Kelly Loeffler as well.

A full vote may force Senators to provide the increment in stimulus before Georgia's run-off-election.

Sen. Bernie Sanders tried to take action after Schumer.

Roy Blunt told the press that their vote wouldn't exceed the 60-vote threshold if it came to it.

Despite Senate's opposition, Sen. Josh emphasized the financial need of struggling Americans.

## What is Joe Biden's Reaction to Trump's Vaccine Distribution Strategy?



Joe Biden shot Trump's administration for underperforming in making their vaccines while outlining the steps he'll take to ramp up the nationwide vaccination.

After vowing to accomplish his 100-million shots in 100 days, he admitted that he'd need additional funding from Congress and federal involvements. He also said that he's planning to utilize the Defense Authorization Act to ramp-up the vaccine production. Despite all this, he cautioned that the span to stretch two months to vaccinate most citizens.

Trump's administration started at a more sluggish pace than the officials have anticipated.

Operation Warp Speed's officials revealed their plans to vaccinate 20 million, but Alex Azar claimed the distribution was 100 million.

Instead, Federal Government said that 11.5 million doses had been sent to the state, of which 2 million have been administered.

Drs. Celine Gounder and Ashish Jha stated that it would take the administration of millions of shots each day to vaccinate the nation by spring and the current pace isn't enough.

Brett Giroir reported that 15.6 million doses would be distributed till the week's end and another 4.2 million next week. While also stating there might be un-recorded people receiving shots.

Biden has warned people to stay vigilant for the future.
